

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POST SECONDARY EDUCATION SCOTT COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 2025

All applications are online at www.scottcf.org Scholarship recipients will be notified in May 2025

A committee will review the anonymous scholarship applications and recommend winners based on the following criteria.

• Future Plans, Community Involvement, High School Activities, Academic Achievement, & Written Communication

Woodrow & Loyal Hoffman Scholarships

• \$5,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students (1 male and 1 female)

• Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

• Hueftle and Hoffman applicants must enroll full-time in college or technical school for the upcoming Fall term.

• Hoffman applicants must attend a school within the State of Kansas.

• Hoffman scholarships only-brief interview with Foundation Trustees. Finalists will be notified by Mrs. Frolich and must be available for an interview.

Everett Hueftle - Scott Community Foundation Scholarship

• \$2,500 total (\$1,500 from SCF & \$1,000 from Hueftle)

- Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students
- 1 male and 1 female; Hoffman interviewees.

Everett Hueftle Scholarships

• \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to six students.

• Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Helmers Family Scholarship

• \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student.

Student must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale

• Renewable for four years subject to funding and the student maintaining a 3.0 GPA.

Glenn Novak Scholarships

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship will be awarded to two students.
- Students must attend a College or University to obtain a degree in an Agricultural or Animal Sciences related field.

• Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Scott Community Foundation Legacy Scholarship

• \$10,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student who must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. SCF Legacy Scholarship only-brief interview with Foundation Trustees. Finalists will be notified by Mrs. Frolich and must be available for an interview.

Albert & Dee Hoeme Memorial Scholarship

• \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student

• Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Labache Ag. Inc, Scholarship

• \$7,500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to two students for two years (\$3,750 each year)

• Student who has the capabilities of getting a college degree but because of financial burden cannot go to college or may not even think or consider getting a college degree.

- Lack of family support to get a degree
- Priority is given to second-generation immigrants that may or may not be legal in the US.

• \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one female SCHS Basketball player and \$500 to one male SCHS football and/or basketball player.

Ruby Wilkens Music Scholarship

- \$1,000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student
- Student must be pursuing a degree in a music-related field

• Renewable Subject to funding

• \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one student

• Student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale

• Open to any Scott Community High School Senior who is planning to major in Agriculture, attend a Vo-Tech school, or major in Welding. Students applying must plan to attend either a University, Junior College, or Vo-Tech School in the school year following graduation.

• \$500 need based, Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate.

• \$5000 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate who will be attending a vocational school.

• \$500 Post-Secondary Scholarship awarded to one SCHS graduate.
