

SCOTT COUNTY MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE SCHOLARSHIP OF SERVICE TO COMMUNITY AND WORLD

The Scott County Ministerial Alliance has established this scholarship in 2018 to provide support for students graduating from the Scott County School District to assist and support them in furthering their education for service to others in trade schools, universities, or further training.

AMOUNT:

Scholarships shall be awarded to four (4) recipients annually in the amount of \$500 each to be paid to the institution for tuition, housing, meals, books, or other required materials (books, equipment, tools, etc.).

ELIGIBILITY:

- Graduates from Scott Community High School with a 2.0 GPA or recipients of the GED program
- Enrolled in a university, college, trade school, or training program

APPLICATION:

Applicants must submit a 300-word essay describing:

- a. The applicants past involvement in the community.
- b. Plans for education and service.
- c. The financial need for the applicant in their education or training.
- d. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or other authority figure.

DEADLINE:

Applications must be received February 26th of the graduating year to be considered for award. Applications may be submitted to the Scott Community Foundation at 210 W. 4th or by email to nicole@scottcf.org
